Feedback:

Financial Report:

- Accounts were audited and all very good
- Latest account balance is \$5499.00 in bank
- \$400 was approved for the Waitati School bags, this has been paid.
- Directories fundraiser costs have all be paid.
- Waiting on final costs of Netball for the term so the PTA can help out with this, should know by end of the month the numbers of children and teams playing.
- \$1000 has been set aside for the cost of food for the senior ski camp

Financial Assistance:

- Rebecca has asked for some funding to help buy new sport equipment – quotes to come
- Mikaela has asked for some funding to purchase some outside tools for her class, a set was around \$1000
- Colette has asked that we think of a long term funding idea for the school, Stacey is going to ask the School committee, but some suggestion were a bike track, and repainting and fencing of the tennis court.

- Stacey has asked the PTA help with costs for the school to take part in Stars on Stage for the cost of the bus or costumes. Looking around \$600
- Class resources, PTA normally pays \$200 per class.

New Matters Arising

- Sinead has come back to us asking for photos to be done 2nd week of August to allow more time for getting them packed and out to families. This would be weather permitting.
- No winter food is to be sold on behalf of the PTA as the seniors are doing hot foods for camp fundraisers.
- The PTA thinks it is a good idea to advertise the directories more through the school, so people are aware that the money is for the school not an outside source, ideas of it being advertised in the Blueskin and on the Facebook page with a push on the school. Colette is going to ask Amy if she is happy to format something for us.
- Matariki– PTA to provide the hot chocolate for families and to do the hall set up. Families are to be told to bring a plate to share, not for just their family.
