

Waitati School (3857)
Enrolment Scheme
Effective from 18 October 2021

The guidelines for development and operation of enrolment schemes are issued under Schedule 20, Clause 3 (3) of the Education and Training Act 2020 for the purpose of describing the basis on which the Secretary's powers in relation to enrolment schemes will be exercised.

Home Zone

All students who live within the home zone described below shall be eligible to enrol at the school.

The Home Zone takes addresses on both sides of the boundary roads mentioned in the description unless otherwise stated.

Starting from the intersection of Leith Valley Road and Pigeon Flat Road, the home zone follows:

- North-west along Leith Valley Road until its intersection with the Dunedin North Motorway (SH 1) and Waitati Valley Road
- North-west along Waitati Valley Road until Donald Road
 - Including Miller Road
- East along Donald Road until the Dunedin North Motorway (SH 1)
 - Including Waitati Valley Road to the north of Donald Road
- North along the Dunedin North Motorway (SH 1) until Double Hill Road
- West along Double Hill Road until Steep Hill Road
 - Including Kilpatrick Road,
 - And including Clark Road
- North along Steep Hill Road until, but not including, 504 Steep Hill Road
 - Including Walker Road
- From here travels south back along Steep Hill Road until its intersection with Walker Road
- From the intersection of Steep Hill Road and Walker Road jumps east to the end of Manse Road
- East along Manse Road until Waikouaiti-Waitati Road (SH 1)
- North along Waikouaiti-Waitati Road (SH 1) up to and including number 1737 Waikouaiti-Waitati Road (SH 1)
- South back along on Waikouaiti-Waitati Road (SH 1) until Harvey Street
 - Including King Street
- East along Harvey Street until Pitt Street
- North-east along Pitt Street until Brown Street
 - Including Brown Street to the north of Pitt Street,
 - Including Pitt Street to the east of Brown Street,
 - And including Mclachlan Street
- South-west along Brown Street until it turns into Doctors Point Road
- South-west then west along Doctors Point Road until the end of Doctors Point Road
 - Including all of the side streets off of Doctors Point Road from Bay Street to White Road
- South back along Doctors Point Road until Foyle Street
- South along Foyle Street until Killarney Street
- West along Killarney Street until Erne Street
- South along Erne Street until Orokonui Road
 - Including Erne Street to the north of Killarney Street
- West along Orokonui Road until Harvey Street
 - Including Orokonui Road to the east of Erne Street,



- And including View Street and all of the side streets off of it
- South along Harvey Street until Shortcut Road
- South-east along Shortcut Road until Blueskin Road
 - Including Dons Creek Road
- South and then west along Blueskin Road until Mopanui Road
 - Including Cedar Creek Road,
 - And including Mopanui Road
- West back along Blueskin Road until Green Road
- West then south along Green Road until Mount Cargill Road
- South along Mount Cargill Road until, and including, 340 Mount Cargill Road
- From 340 Mount Cargill Road jumps west to the end of O'Connell Road
- West along O'Connell Road until Pigeon Flat Road
- West along Pigeon Flat Road until its intersection with Leith Valley Road

Special Programmes

This priority category is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a Special programme approved by the Secretary.

Out of Zone Enrolments

Each year the Board of Trustees will determine the number of places which are likely to be available in the following year for the enrolment of students who live outside the home zone. The Board will publish this information by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school. The notice will indicate how applications are to be made and will specify a date by which all applications must be received.

Applications for enrolments will be processed in the following order of priority:

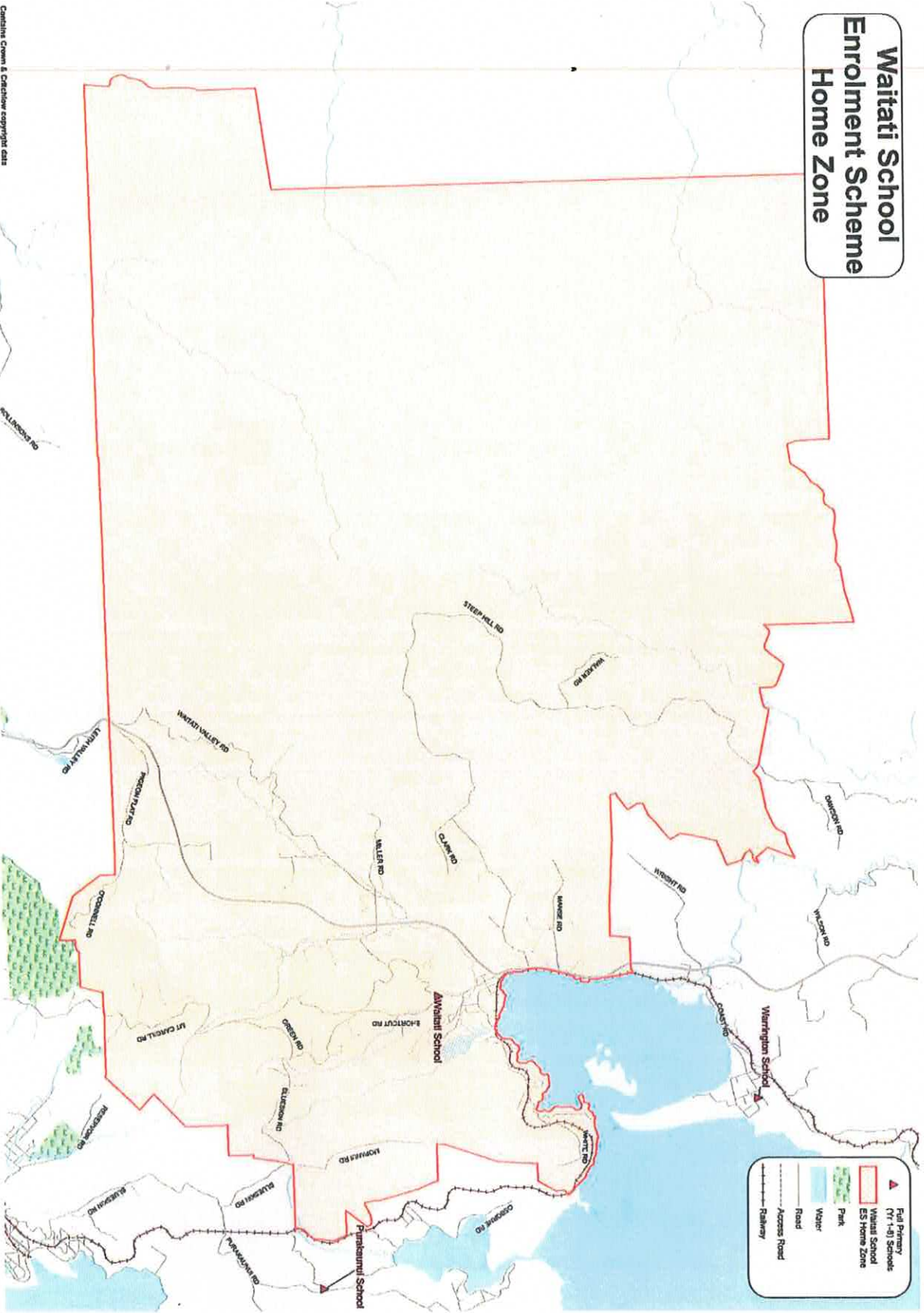

| <u>First Priority</u> | This priority is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a special programme approved by the Secretary for Education. |
| <u>Second Priority</u> | will be given to applicants who are siblings of current students. |
| <u>Third Priority</u> | will be given to applicants who are siblings of former students. |
| <u>Fourth Priority</u> | will be given to any applicant who is a child of a former student of the school. |
| <u>Fifth Priority</u> | will be given to any applicant who is either a child of an employee of the board of the school or a child of a member of the board of the school. |
| <u>Sixth Priority</u> | will be given to all other applicants. |

If there are more applicants in the second, third, fourth, fifth or sixth priority groups than there are places available, selection within the priority group will be by ballot conducted in accordance with instructions by the Secretary, under Schedule 20, Clause 3 (1) of the Education and Training Act 2020. Parents will be informed of the date of any ballot by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school.

Applicants seeking second or third priority status may be required to give proof of a sibling relationship.
